Our School

St. Rose of Lima’s College was founded on 23rd February, 1948 by the Franciscan Missionaries of Mary (F.M.M.) to cater to the needs of Hong Kong society. It is a government subsidised Catholic school for girls which emphasises a very strong moral upbringing. Our school motto is “Through Charity to Truth”.

To meet the challenge of quality education and the need for more space for development, our school moved to a new building at 29 Ngan Shing Street, Shatin in September, 1999. This change ensures that our students will enjoy a better, more spacious and well-equipped learning environment.

From the time it was founded in 1948, St. Rose of Lima’s College has had the characteristics of an extended family with a close relationship among teachers and students. We have always managed to retain the atmosphere of gentility and friendliness while remaining alert and receptive to constructive changes.

As a unique EMI girls’ school in Shatin, all subjects (except Chinese Language, Putonghua, Chinese History, Religious Education and Moral & Civic Education) are taught in English.

Major Concerns (Reflection)

OBJECTIVES FOR THE YEAR 2009 – 2010

School Theme : Nurturing the Garden of Charity, Tending the Roses of Truth

Areas of major concern for the following years (2009 – 2012):

- ***Enhancing our English Learning Environment***
- ***Promoting a Healthy Mind***
- ***Implementing the New Senior Secondary Curriculum***

Our students were very good in general and they had good achievements in many areas. The students in Form 1 and Form 2 showed significant progress in their manners and behaviour. The work of the Moral Education Core Group should be extended to Form 3.

Some students were still passive and some gave up when they had difficulties. Some students in the NSS cohort had difficulties and pressure. Positive thinking / attitude should be cultivated. We had to focus more on our students' sense of responsibility and curb their tendency to give up when they encountered difficulties.

The Cross-curricular Project Learning Committee had collaborated with the Liberal Studies Department in undertaking the Project Learning work.

The students had shown considerable improvement in their reading habits. The student helpers and the teachers in the Reading Committee had done a lot of work. The Reading Ambassador Programme undertaken in collaboration with St. Rose of Lima's Primary School was a success.

Other Learning Experiences (OLE) formed an important part of students' learning experience in school. Our students were not acutely aware of what happened around them. Students' reflection was essential. The Form 1 Education Camp and the Prefects' Training Camp would also be held during the OLE days.

The school would continue to use the Capacity Enhancement Grant to employ teachers and teaching assistants for the four core subjects.

More talks, seminars and experience-sharing sessions should be arranged for parents to cater for their needs.

Future Planning

The Home Room lessons would be re-structured so some core messages could be delivered during the Home Room and include more career-related, Moral Education and Liberal Studies activities. Class teachers would supervise the activities since they needed to know what students were doing. More staff development workshops relating to guidance and discipline, and even special education needs should be held for the teachers.

There was a significant decrease in the number of students in Hong Kong, especially in Shatin district. This should not affect our student numbers for now, but it was expected that it would have an effect on the diversity of our student population.

Under the fine-tuning policy of the MOI announced by the Government, we had the professional discretion to offer 5 EMI classes for the six cohorts from 2010-11 to 2015-16. A review would be conducted during 2014-15 and 2015-16 to determine the number of EMI classes in the next six cohorts starting in 2016-17 based on our student intake. We had to maintain our standards and uphold our excellent traditions to make sure that we remained an EMI school.

The Medium of Instruction in the school must be English as our students were capable and we had higher expectations of them. Teachers should provide extra help to weaker students and repeaters in the junior forms.

We had to decide whether we wanted to keep the Through-train mode. Feeder schools should decide whether or not to follow the "through-train" system by 31st May 2015 (postponed by 3 years).
